July 21, 1922 - August 4, 2025

Homer Nathan Leymaster, 103, died on Monday, August 4, 2025, at MercyOne Cedar Falls Medical Center.

He was born on July 21, 1922, in Aurora, Nebraska, the son of Leslie and Addie Frances (Wertman) Leymaster. He served in the U.S. Army Reserves from 1943 to 1945, attaining the rank of Major. On June 11, 1947, he was united in marriage to Ruth Anne Medaris in Aurora, NE. Homer earned his bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and worked as the general manager for Doerfer Engineering before his retirement in 1984. He was also a dedicated member of the Masons and El-Kahir Shrine.

Homer is survived by his three children: Bruce (Russ) Leymaster of Upton, MA, Sherry (James) Buhrmann of Gretna, NE, and Ted (Cheryl) Leymaster of Independence, IA; three grandchildren: Kara (Randy) Steffen of Liverpool, NY, Nick (Joni) Leymaster of Marion, IA, and Lee Buhrmann of Gretna, NE; and ten great grandchildren: Alex, Max, Sophia, Henry, Timothy, Lucas, and Neil Steffen, Kale, Brady, and Zac Leymaster.
