CEDAR FALLS-Jack E. Parsons, 62, of Marshalltown, formerly of Davenport and Cedar Falls, died Saturday, October 30, 2010 at the Veterans Home in Marshalltown.

He was born November 7, 1947, in Cedar Falls, Iowa the son of John Lewis and LaVonne Georgia (Carolus) Parsons. He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1966 and attended the University of Northern Iowa for one year. He served his country in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam Era. On October 5, 1969, he was united in marriage to Kathie Jo Kapela in Hudson, Iowa. They were later divorced. He was employed as a system technician at the Rock Island Arsenal, retiring in 1990 due to health issues. He was active at the Peace of Peace Lutheran Church in Davenport, an avid sports enthusiast, and enjoyed bowling.

Survived by two daughters, Heather L. (Mark) Ruschitzko of Austin, TX and Amber (Jeff) Leech of Geneseo, IL; three brothers, Rick (Diane) Parsons of Ft. Collins, CO, Chuck (Cathy) Parsons of Cedar Falls, and Mark (Terry) Parsons of Dike; and one sister, Kim Ellen (Clifford) Moye of Reinbeck.
