Jack Marlowe Scott (1930-2019)

CEDAR FALLS – Jack Marlowe Scott, 89, of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died Monday, December 2, at MercyOne Cedar Falls Medical Center.

He was born March 14, 1930, in Hastings, Nebraska, son of Fredrick and Bernice (McPeak) Scott. He married Willa Jean Bryant and they later divorced. He then married Barbara Sidler in 1978 in Cedar Falls.

He graduated from Hastings High School in 1948 and joined the Navy. After Basic Training, he attended the Navy School of Music in Washington DC, and was then stationed with the Navy Band at Naval Station Great Lakes near Chicago. He owned and operated Scott Litho, Inc., until retiring.
