James was born on February 11, 1939, in Sumner, Iowa, the son of Donald Esmond and Inez Marie (Ehleri) McCue.

He married Shirley Riggle in May 1965, and they later divorced. James was then united in marriage to Susan A. Broad on November 11, 1993 in Cedar Falls.

James served in the United States Army. He retired from the IAARNG on Feb. 11, 1999, as the HHC 1st BN 133rd INF CO 1SG-E8. Combined with active duty in the 82nd Airborne and IAARNG, James had a total of 33 ? years service. He was later employed with Friendship Village as a wheel chair van driver for 10 years.
