



Jane Duddles

April 20, 1927 - May 11, 2012

Jane Frye Duddles went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Friday morning, May 11, 2012. She was a resident of Windhaven Assisted Living in Cedar Falls.

She was born April 20, 1927 on a farm near Hughesville, Missouri, daughter of Bert Scott Frye and Laura (Peithman) Frye. She grew up on the farm with her five brothers and one sister. Jane graduated from Smith Cotton High School in Sedalia, Missouri and also from Bob Jones University in Greenville, South Carolina with a degree in Education.

After teaching a short time in Oregon, Jane married Ralph T. Duddles in Kansas City, Missouri on March 24, 1951. She worked in an office at the University of Minnesota Medical School until Ralph graduated. Jane and Ralph lived in Iowa and California before going to Belgium for training and eventually to the Belgian Congo in Africa as medical missionaries with the Evangelical Free Church of America. They returned to America in 1959 due to poor health and were then active in founding an Evangelical Free Church in Sacramento, California. After living in various locations in California and Colorado, they moved to Ames, IA in 1977. Ralph passed away from cancer in 1978. She later moved to Cedar Falls to be near her daughter and family.

Jane was devoted to her faith in God and her family. She enjoyed helping

those around her and watching her children and grandchildren grow over the years.

She is survived by her son, Thomas M. (Laura) Duddles of Warner Robins, Georgia;

her daughter, Marilyn D. (Bruce) Baridon of Cedar Falls, Iowa and 12 grandchildren,
