CEDAR FALLS – Jean Noble Huffman, 98, of Dayton, Ohio, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Sunday, December 18, 2016, in Dayton.

She was born July 30, 1918 in Cedar Falls, daughter of William Edward and Florence (Stewart) Noble. She married Robert C. Huffman and he preceded her in death.

She earned her BS degree from the University of Michigan. She and her husband represented the government and people of the United States on diplomatic postings to Singapore, Frankfurt, Bonn, Washington D.C., Nigeria, Zurich, Bern, Vancouver and Dusseldorf. Later, she served as a Stephen Minister at the La Jolla Presbyterian Church.
