Jeane continued her active lifestyle and was awarded Arkansas' State Senior Award and was also the Super Senior Golf Champion in 1993. She and Jerry loved to play golf with friends and enjoy time on the lake in Cherokee Village. When Jeane relocated back to Iowa to be closer to her daughter, she became an enthusiastic supporter of UNI and attended as many sporting and cultural events as possible.
