



## Jennie B. Fielding

July 22, 1919 - November 16, 2018

CEDAR FALLS-Jennie B. "Jen" Fielding, 99, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, November 16, 2018, at Sartori Memorial Hospital in Cedar Falls.

She was born July 22, 1919, in Rosholt, SD, the daughter of Wellman C. and Ella E. Renner Cummings. She married Russell C. Fielding November 20, 1944 in Bremerton, WA. He died May 7, 1984.

She had many jobs in the Cedar Valley, among which was teaching swim lessons at the Cedar Falls Pools and the YWCA in Waterloo and head usher at the UNI Dome from 1976 until 2014.

Survived by: two sons, Roger D. (Vicky) Fielding of Spring Green, WI and Roy R. (Mary Gaye) Fielding of Charlotte, NC; two grandchildren; three great grandchildren; and sister, Sylvia M. Brooks of Waterloo.
