



Jerrold "Jerry" Jacobsen

May 12, 1925 - February 28, 2018

Cedar Falls – Jerrold “Jerry” Edward Jacobsen, age 92, of Cedar Falls, died Wednesday, February 28, 2018 at Western Home Communities Martin Center. He was born May 12, 1925 in Kansas City, MO, the son of S.C. and Leone (Short) Jacobsen. He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in the class 1943. He served in the US Army Air Corps from 1943-1945. He earned a bachelor’s degree from Grinnell College in 1949 and a law degree (JD) from the University of Iowa in 1952. On March 21, 1951, he married Susan Jewell on Grosse Ile, Michigan. He worked as an attorney in Cedar Falls for 62 years retiring in 2015.
