Jeruld Saxton “Jerry” Marsh (1936-2019)

CEDAR FALLS – Jeruld Saxton “Jerry” Marsh, 82, of Cedar Falls died Monday, June 24, 2019 at his home.

He was born September 19, 1936 in Charles City, Iowa, son of Harold Leroy and Lois Mildred (Allison) Marsh. He married Mary Jane Asleson on December 29, 1961 in Nashua, Iowa.

He graduated from Charles City High School in 1954 and earned a degree in Mechanical Engineering from Iowa State College (University) in 1958. He served in the U.S. Army Reserves and was employed with Viking Pump in 1961, retiring as Vice President of Engineering in 1991. He served with the Cedar Falls AMVETS Post 49 Honor Guard and was Past Commodore of the North Shore Boat Club.
