Jesse Gene Adelmund, age 71, of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died Saturday February 22, 2025, at his home surrounded by his family.

Jess was born on December 8, 1953, at Sartori Hospital in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of John and Dorothy (Abbas) Adelmund. He attended New Hartford High School, graduating in 1972.
