James McClintock, 81, died on Sunday, March 9, 2025, at his home in Cedar Falls.

He was born on August 6, 1943, in Waterloo, IA, the son of Delmer and Marion (Guenther) McClintock. He served in the Marine Corps. On September 7, 1973, he was united in marriage to Lorrita Scott in Galena, IL. Jim worked maintenance at John Deere, retiring in 1997, then was employed with Silver Eagle Harley Davidson until 2011. He was also a member of the Cedar Falls Eagles and the Black Hawk Lodge #65, and the El Kahir Shrine.

Jim is survived by his wife, Rita; son, Doug McClintock; daughters, Jeannie (Claudio) Marquez and Melissa (Dave) McClintock-Adelmund; six grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.
