WATERLOO-JoAnn Marie Chapman, 73, of Waterloo, died Thursday, June 20, 2013 at Rochester Methodist Hospital in Rochester, MN.

She was born August 27, 1939, the daughter of Oscar C. and Gladys Marie Meyne Hurd. She married Jerry Lee Chapman June 6, 1964, in Davenport, IA. They were later divorced.

JoAnn received her Bachelor of Science degree from Macalester College in St. Paul, MN, and a Master of Arts degree in Public Health from the University of Minnesota, and was awarded a fellowship at the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania. She was employed as Vice President of Nursing and Patient Care Services at St Francis then Covenant Medical Center until 1989 and later was Executive Director of the Visiting Nurses Association. She valued excellence in nursing and continuing nursing education.

Survived by two sons, Todd (Cindy) Chapman of Zackery, LA and Scott Chapman of Deerfield, IL; three grandchildren, Taylor (Ken) McClelland, and Christian and Connor Chapman, all of Zackery, LA; great grandchild, Keigan McLelland of Zackery, LA; sister, Judy (Virgil) Kuhlmann of Readlyn; and brother, Jim (Judy) Hurd of Waterloo.
