CEDAR FALLS- Dr. John R. Moes, 84, of Cedar Falls, died Monday, June 22, 2015 at the Western Home Communities Thalman Square.

He was born October 25, 1930, in Galena, Illinois, son of Joseph A. and Julia M. (Lawlor) Moes. He married Patricia J. Brown on October 21, 1961 and they later divorced.
