CEDAR FALLS-John Curtis Muncy, 79, of Cedar Falls died Saturday, August 27, 2011 at Allen Memorial Hospital in Waterloo.

He was born July 28, 1932, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of Fred and Elsie Wilmarth Muncy. He married Margaret Thomae on June 20, 1958, in Gladbrook. She died June 7, 1993.

Mr. Muncy graduated from Iowa State Teachers College High School and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture from Iowa State University. He also received a Master of Arts degree in Education in Educational Media and a Master of Arts degree in Library Science, both from the University of Northern Iowa.

He served in the United States Army from 1954-1956 and again from 1961-1962.

He taught Vocational Agriculture for several years, and also taught Educational Media at the University of Northern Iowa. He then worked as a Reference Librarian at the Cedar Falls Public Library for twenty-two years. Survivors include: a son, John of Cedar Falls, a daughter, Nancy Muncy of Cedar Falls; and a sister, Corinne Brown of Story City.
