John "Jack" Weigel (1938-2011)

CEDAR FALLS- John "Jack" Weigel, 73, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, April 20, 2011, at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home, Waterloo.

He was born January 18, 1938 in New Hampton, Iowa, the son of Irwin and Nellie (Fitzgerald) Weigel. He married Doris Kriener on April 18, 1959 at St. Luke's Catholic Church, St. Lucas, Iowa.

He graduated from New Hampton High School and received his airline training from Gale Institute, Minneapolis. He was employed by American Airlines in Chicago, Ozark Airlines in Mason City and Fort Dodge, and transferred to the Waterloo Airport in 1961. With the Ozark/TWA merger, he transferred to the Cedar Rapids Airport and Des Moines International Airport, retiring in 1999 after 40 years of service. He worked part-time at Dan Deery Motors from January 2000 to January 2010. He was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, and the Sons of AMVETS Post 49, Cedar Falls.
