Joshua Charles Pinkham, 37, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, in Cedar Falls.

Josh was born on April 26, 1987, in Missouri, the son of Charles “Todd” and Debra (Donahue) Pinkham. He graduated in 2005 from Gridley High School in El Paso, IL. He proudly served in the U.S. Army and retired after 18 years of service. On August 22, 2014, he was united in marriage to Kelsey Jarchow in Fort Walton Beach, FL. He was employed with Collins Aerospace in Cedar Rapids as a security advisor.

He enjoyed many hobbies including riding his motorcycle, golf, working-out, RC cars, loving on the family's dogs, and biking with his wife and son.

Josh enlisted in the Army in June of 2005, as a Combat Infantryman. After completing One Station Unit Training and Airborne School at Ft. Benning GA., his first duty station was at Camp Casey in Korea. He then went to Ranger School in 2008 and upon graduation was assigned to Ft. Lewis, WA with 1-17 IN 5th Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division. Following that assignment, he went on to Eglin AFB where he was assigned to 6thRTB. Josh worked numerous unique jobs in the military from a Florida Phase Ranger School Instructor to a Dog Handler with United States Army Special Operations Command.

In 2016, Josh was assigned to Headquarters, U.S. Army Special Operations Command, where he deployed in support of Operation Inherent Resolve numerous times and received multiple citations for his actions overseas defending his country. Josh served his country with honor and distinction.
