



## Joyce E. Kloster

September 13, 1928 - February 7, 2017

Joyce Elaine Kloster, 88, of Cedar Falls, Iowa, died Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at Bartels Lutheran Retirement Community in Waverly.

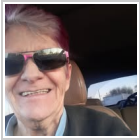
