CEDAR FALLS- Joyce Ann Knoll, 66, of Cedar Falls, died March 30, 2015.

She was born August 14, 1948 in Iowa Falls, daughter of Fernando and Marjorie (West) Hartwig. She married Brock Kincaid Knoll on June 16, 1972, in Traer, Iowa.

She graduated from Conrad High school (BCL) and received her Associate of Arts degree from Ellsworth Community College. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Art Education from the University of Northern Iowa where she also did graduate studies. She taught in the Waterloo and Cedar Falls school systems.

She was a board member of the Black Hawk (now Cedar Bend) Humane Society. She was co-chair of the Black Hawk-Bremer League of Women Voters. Joyce's passions in life were her loving husband of 42 years, the arts, books, history, flower gardening, and everything related with nature.
