Juanita Seamens Dempster, 88, of Cedar Falls, formerly of Waterloo and Melbourne, Florida, died Saturday, April 17, 2010, at her home on the Windcove Campus of Western Home Communities in Cedar Falls.

She was born November 30, 1921, in Fairbank, Iowa, the daughter of Will and Laura Dean Seamens. She graduated from Fairbank High School in 1937 at the age of 15. She married Edwin A. Dempster on February 14, 1939, in Manchester, Iowa. He died March 7, 2004.
