



## Lance L. White

June 6, 1964 - September 20, 2019

Cedar Falls – Lance L. White, age 55, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, September 20, 2019 at MercyOne Cedar Falls.

He was born June 6, 1964, the son of Dick and Barbara (Bacon) White in Portland, OR. He graduated from Cedar Falls High School in the class of 1983. He worked for Jerry Steward Trucking, and then Cedar Valley Freightliner which became Harrison Truck Centers as a parts salesman. He later worked as a journeyman electrician for Cedar Valley Electric. At the time of his death he was an independent contractor.

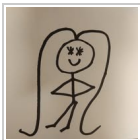
