Larry Eugene Evans, age 75, passed away Sunday morning, December 30, at his home in Cedar Falls, Iowa, after a long battle with cancer.

He was born to parents Robert and Dorothy (Kelley) Evans on December 9, 1943, in Cedar Falls, Iowa. Larry graduated from Cedar Falls High School in the class of 1963, worked at Construction Machinery Company (CMC) and retired from Cedar Falls Community Schools.
