



Larry Dean Everts

July 4, 1941 - April 26, 2026

Larry D. Everts, age 84, of Cedar Falls, passed from this life into the arms of his Savior with his wife Dianne by his side on Sunday, April 26, 2026, at NewAldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls. Larry lived a life marked by faith, family and an adventurous spirit.

He was born July 4, 1941, in Cedar Falls, Iowa, the son of Fred and Tena (Hoodjer) Everts. He graduated from Dike High School in the class of 1959. Larry worked on the farm, hauled milk, and worked at the University of Northern Iowa as an equipment operator, in retirement, drove for the YMCA, Bridges, Cozy Van and NewAldaya. Larry married Lynda Engel on December 15, 1961, they later divorced. On May 31, 1985, Larry was united in marriage to Dianne Mohler in Cedar Falls.

Larry loved being with people, especially the 30+ international students he and Dianne hosted over the years. He loved going to visit his nearby Amish friends for fellowship and meals. Larry treasured all his friends from various church congregations, including CF Evangelical Free and the CF Bible Conference. Larry enjoyed watching NASCAR, going fishing, playing table games and cards. He loved gospel music, especially the Gaithers.

Larry is survived by his wife, Dianne Everts of Evansdale; two sons, Dean (Michelle) Everts of Parkersburg, David (Jodi) Everts of Parkersburg; his

daughter, Kristin Schneiderman of Parkersburg; his stepchildren, Curtis (Juliet) Mohler of Bulverde, TX, Cathrine Soto of Chula Vista, CA; 13 grandchildren, Kyle and Kelton Everts, Josh Schneiderman, Cortney Julifs, Hayley Marcinkus, Jacob Everts, McKenzi James, Avari Everts, Justin Mohler, Shauna Mohler, Danielle Mohler, Eric Soto, Eliana Soto; and 10 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, and step-daughter Cynthia Lynn Mohler.

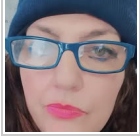

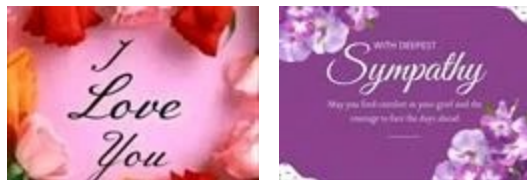
