CEDAR FALLS – Larry L. Larsen, 78, of Lansing, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Monday, November 2nd at Thornton Manor Care Center in Lansing.

He was born February 3, 1942 in Cedar Falls, son of Glen and Della (Butcher) Larsen. He graduated from Teachers College High School in Cedar Falls in 1961 and attended a year of college in Wenatchee, WA. On July 26, 1963, he married Melinda Pittman at Nazareth Lutheran Church in Cedar Falls. Larry retired in April 1993 from John Deere, where he was employed as a supervisor.
