WATERLOO ? Larry C. Polen, 67, of Waterloo, died Thursday, Aug. 7, at Cox Health Systems, Springfield, Mo.

He was born Oct. 3, 1940, in Springfield, Ill., son of Calvin A. "Cap" and Florence Bokus Polen, and was raised by his mother and stepfather, Florence and George Pinske. He married Ingrid D. Colter on Dec. 7, 1968, in Ottawa, Ill. She died April 8, 2003.
