Le Roy L. Corwin Sr (1940-2009)

CEDAR FALLS- Le Roy L. Corwin Sr, 68, of Cedar Falls died Sunday, October 4, 2009 at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home.

He was born October 9, 1940 in Cedar Falls, the son of Lyell L. and Fannie (Schneiderman) Corwin. He married Sylvia J. Scott on February 28, 1962 in Cedar Falls. She died August 31, 1994.

Mr. Corwin served in the United States Navy from 1957 to 1961, and then was employed with John Deere Waterloo Tractor Works for twenty-nine years, retiring in 1995. He was a member of Black Hawk Lodge #65 A.F. and A.M., El Kahir Shrine, Cedar Falls AMVETS Post 49, and Eagles.
