Leah was born December 30, 1932, in Lebanon, IN, the daughter of Ernest and Zora (Martin) Hiland. She graduated from Lebanon, IN High School and went on to receive her B.S. (1955), M.A.L.A. (1960) and Ph.D (1973) all from Indiana University. Prior to receiving her advanced degrees, she taught high school in Flosmoor, IN, military base Germany and Merrillville, IN. She then was Assistant Professor, School of Library Science, University of Iowa (1969-72), then Assistant Professor, Department of Library Science, University of Northern Iowa from 1972 until her retirement in 1994. During her time at UNI, she served as Coordinator for the Division of School Library Media Studies from 1991-1994.
