Leona A. Heth, 90, of Cedar Falls, formerly of Jesup, Fairbank, and Sumner, died Sunday, February 19, 2006, at her daughter's home in Sumner.

She was born December 31, 1915, in Randalia, Iowa, the daughter of Fred and Mary (Glennin) Handley.
