WAVERLY – Lesley B. Toma, 42, of Waverly, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Thursday, July 5, 2018 at her home of cancer.

She was born February 8, 1976 in Burlington, Vermont, daughter of Robert and Sarah (Cook) Henderson. She married Troy Toma on August 23, 2003 in Clinton Twp., Michigan.
