



Lewis Eugene Janssen

October 7, 1931 - October 3, 2021

Lewis Eugene “Gene” Janssen of Cedar Falls died peacefully at Unity Point-Allen Memorial Hospital in Waterloo on Sunday, Oct. 3, 2021. He would have celebrated his 90th birthday, Oct. 7th. He was born in 1931 in Cedar Falls, IA to Albert E. & Marjorie (Brunk) Janssen. After graduating from Cedar Falls High School in 1949 he completed his BA degree in Business Education at Iowa State Teachers College (now UNI) in Dec. 1954.

He joined the U.S. Navy in 1953, and was in Reserves prior, and after having 2 years active duty on the Bon Homme Richard (CVA-31). He received an honorable discharge in 1966.

After teaching at high schools in Lamont and Finchford, his primary employment was being a bookkeeper for Rasmusson’s & Dick Witham’s Chevrolet and Crossroads Ford dealerships for 32 years, retiring in 1996. Gene was married to Alice Bunnell on June 14, 1959 at 1st Baptist Church, Cedar Falls, IA. During their 62 years of marriage they lived in Cedar Falls, Des Moines, Waterloo and back to Cedar Falls where they have resided since 1965. He was a member of Trinity Bible Church.

Survivors include his wife, son-Steve (Donna) Janssen, Marquette, NE; two daughters-Pam (Andy) Johnson, Bayport, MN, and Connie (Shawn) McAlpine, Ashland, MT; Grandchildren-Ben and Olivia Janssen, Aaron Longnecker, Rachael (Ben) Borowske, Alex (Haley) Roeller, Alicia and Luke McAlpine; Great-grandchildren-Gavin, Mason & Hannah Borowske, with a 4th one on the way.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Veldon R. Janssen.

Funeral service will be held Saturday, Oct 23 at 1:30 at Trinity Bible Church, with visitation Friday from 6-8 p.m at Richardson Funeral Home, both in Cedar Falls. Private interment will be held at Cedar Valley Memorial Gardens.
