Linda Gayle Culbertson, 77, of Cedar Falls, died on Sunday, April 14, 2024, at the University of Iowa Hospitals & Clinics after a brief illness, surrounded by her loved ones.

She was born on September 25, 1946, in Port Huron, MI, the daughter of Lee and Alberta (Vatter) Bondy. She was united in marriage to Frank Sole on January 23, 1965, in Las Vegas, NV. They later divorced. On May 2, 1986, she married Russell Culbertson in Seaview, WA.

She served as a registered nurse in emergency rooms in Washington and California. She later worked as an Army nurse at the Walter Reed Medical Center in Maryland during Desert Storm. After moving to the Cedar Valley, she worked for Peoples Clinic and the Iowa Blood Bank. She received her master's degree in counseling from the University of Northern Iowa. In her spare time, Linda enjoyed reading, going to the casino, cooking Sunday dinners for her family, and hosting pool parties at their home on Tremont.
