CEDAR FALLS- Lois S. Rannells, 88, of Cedar Falls died Saturday, February 7, 2015 at the Western Home Communities Elizabeth E. Martin Health Center.

She was born June 17, 1926 in Dunlap, Iowa, daughter of Patrick and Mary O'Connor Shields. She married Paul Rannells on November 2, 1946 in Dunlap. He died January 18, 2007.
