CEDAR FALLS- Loren W. Clabough, 79, of Cedar Falls died Wednesday, November 16, 2011 at Cedar Falls Healthcare Center.

He was born October 17, 1932 in Swanton (rural Parkersburg), son of Clyde and Marie Younker Clabough. He married Harriet M. Stanton on December 27, 1952 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Greene.
