



Mac McCampbell

July 20, 1943 - December 22, 2023

CEDAR FALLS - Ronald Lee "Mac" McCampbell, 80, died on Friday, December 22, 2023, at Western Home Communities, The Suites.

He was born on July 20, 1943, in Keokuk, IA, the son of Carroll and Bonnie (Nellis) McCampbell. He graduated from Waterloo West High School. On June 30, 1961, he was united in marriage to Sharon Pollock in Cedar Falls. He joined the U.S. Air Force in 1961 and served actively until 1972, then joined the Iowa Air National Guard in 1982 where he achieved the rank of Chief Master Sergeant before retiring from the service at 29 years in 2000.

Mac was multi-talented and changed careers multiple times over the years as he moved his family from state to state including Nebraska, Louisiana, Virginia, Arizona, Colorado, Illinois, and Iowa. Although he worked as a supervisor for John Deere, an Optometry Tech, in window design and sales and in security, he was always most proud of his military service and career.

Mac was an avid reader and accomplished artist and wood worker and was very proud of his wife, children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Mac is survived by his wife, Sharon; son, Shawn (Lisa) McCampbell of Florence, AZ; daughter, Dawn (Kip) Jacobsen of Alma, WI; grandchildren, Ashley (Matt) Carter of Kansas City, MO, Jake McCampbell of Mesa, AZ, Nick

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Rosemary.
