



Marcella "Sally" Mary Carney

April 4, 1915 - February 21, 2014

CEDAR FALLS-Marcella M. "Sally" Carney, 98, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, February 21, 2014 at Covenant Medical Center in Waterloo.

She was born April 4, 1915 in Devon, Iowa, the daughter of Edmond and Frances Roethler Ungs. She married Harold C. "Clair" Carney April 4, 1934 in North Washington, Iowa. He died March 5, 1996.

Sally graduated from North Washington School and was employed as a cook at the University of Northern Iowa and later at the Brown Bottle Restaurant, both in Cedar Falls.
