Marcidas "Babe" Simon (1923-2015)

PARKERSBURG- Marcidas "Babe" Simon, 92, of Parkersburg died Sunday, November 1, 2015 at Parker Place Retirement Community in Parkersburg.

She was born January 21, 1923 in Parkersburg, daughter of Ward and Hazel (Pierce) Card. She married Raymond Simon on April 6, 1942 in New Harford, and they later divorced.

She graduated from Parkersburg High School in 1941 and was a waitress for 20 years and was a Stanley dealer for 30 years. She was a baptized member of Bethel Lutheran Church, American Legion Auxiliary President for 17 years and Hawkeye Valley Volunteer of the Year.

Babe placed crosses and flags on Veterans graves for Memorial Day for 80 plus years and started Avenue of Flags; served on the Historical Board, Election Board, Republican Central Committee of Black Hawk and Butler; was a Scout Leader, Stanley Group Leader, and Allen Hospital volunteer.

Survived by: a daughter, Beverly Redenius of Cedar Falls; son, Scott (Connie) Simon of Parkersburg; six grandchildren; fourteen great grandchildren; and six great-great grandchildren.

Preceded in death by: a son, Ronn W. Simon and grandson-in-law, Jeffrey Dunakey.

Services: 1:00 p.m. Thursday at the Parkersburg Veterans Building with burial in Oak Hill Cemetery, Parkersburg. Visitation from 4 to 7 p.m. Wednesday at Richardson Funeral Service, Cedar Falls.
