Margauret Sinclair (1922-2015)

CEDAR FALLS- Margauret Sinclair, 93, of Cedar Falls, died Friday, October 23, 2015 at the Western Home Communities Stanard Family Assisted Living Center.

She was born January 27, 1922 in Waverly, daughter of Lester and Rosabel Sickles Loveland. She married Donald J. Sinclair on March 31, 1950 in Janesville. He died June 5, 2003.

She earned her RN degree from St. Luke's Hospital in Cedar Rapids and went on to serve in the United States Army as a nurse during World War II. She worked as a nurse at Sartori Memorial Hospital in Cedar Falls; St Luke's Hospital and Rockwell Collins both in Cedar Rapids, and finally until her retirement at the Good Samaritan Nursing Home in Forest City, IA.

Survived by: a daughter, Cora Sinclair of Omaha, NE; a son, Ed Sinclair of Appleton, WI; grandson, Samuel Sinclair of Appleton, WI; sister, Kay (Allen) Messerschmidt of Cedar Falls; and many nieces and nephews.
