CEDAR FALLS- Margery G. Standley, 94, of Denver, Colorado, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Sunday, December 25, 2011 at Rose Medical Center in Denver.

She was born July 29, 1917 in Stockport, Iowa, daughter of Walker A. and Neva E. (Beidman) Johnston. She married Harlan Standley on July 3, 1938 in Ottumwa. He died February 24, 2005.

Mrs. Standley graduated from Stockport High School and attended Parsons College in Fairfield. She taught in rural, one room schools in the Stockport area, and later was a homemaker, seamstress, and worked in the resource center at Cedar Falls High School.
