Martha L. McCutcheon, 90, died Tuesday, December 7, 2021, under the care of hospice at the Deery Suites in Cedar Falls.

She was born November 21, 1931, in Elm Springs, Arkansas, daughter of Floyd and Jewel (Sherman) Stevens. Martha graduated from East High in Des Moines in 1949, and from Iowa State University in 1954. On December 19, 1954, she married James McCutcheon in Des Moines.
