September 5, 1928 - September 29, 2005

Marvin was born September 5, 1928, in Scotch Grove, Iowa, the son of Irvin Carl and Hanna (Rink) Himebaugh. He served his Country in the United States Army during 1946-1948. He then attended Midwest School of Building Trades in Bloomington, IL. On April 2, 1951, he was united in marriage to Hazel M. Stoakes in Nashua, Iowa. She died July 4, 2004. He retired in 1990 from Prairie Construction as Director of Field Operations after 40 years of employment. He was a member of the Cedar Falls AMVETS Post #49, where he served as Past Commander.
