Marvin Eugene Kroemer passed away peacefully at his home in Cedar Falls on Friday, January 16th, 2026, at the age of 87. He was born in Cedar Falls, Iowa, on December 15th, 1938, to the late Willie and Mabel (North) Kroemer.
