August 20, 1946 - December 18, 2006

Marvin W. Lewis, 60, of Waterloo, died Monday, December 18, 2006, at the Cedar Valley Hospice Home in Waterloo.

He was born August 20, 1946, in Waterloo, the son of Morran and Margaret (Peatow) Lewis. He married Nancy Minikus in 1964. They later divorced. He married Janet L. Walton on May 15, 1977.
