Mary Margaret Connell Davis, 98, of Cedar Falls, returned to our Lord on Friday, April 10th, 2020. Mary was a resident of Deery Suites in Cedar Falls. Mary was born on June 12, 1921, in Cedar Falls, daughter of Margaret Morgan Connell and Charles John Connell. Mary attended St. Patrick Grade School, graduated from Cedar Falls High School in 1938, and attended Iowa State Teacher's College in Cedar Falls. She married Grant Beryl Davis, on April 19, 1941, at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Cedar Falls. He died August 18, 1994.

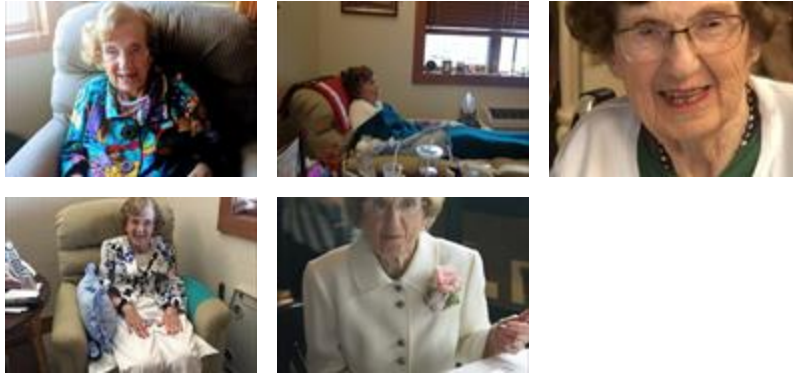
