CEDAR FALLS-Mary Judith Jensen, 85, of Cedar Falls, IA, formerly of Port Clinton, OH, Fayetteville, PA, and Davenport, IA, died Sunday, August 12, 2012 at NewAldaya Lifescapes in Cedar Falls.

She was born December 27, 1926, in Bessemer, AL, daughter of Edmund and Mary Palmer Sherrod. She married Robert Jensen September 23, 1946, in Memphis, TN. He died April 30, 1998.
