Mary Kathryn "Kitty" Cunningham (1940-2015)

CORALVILLE – Mary Kathryn "Kitty" Cunningham, 75, of Coralville, formerly of Cedar Falls, died Wednesday, December 9, 2015, at Windmill Manor in Coralville.

She was born February 3, 1940, in Waterloo, Iowa, daughter of Ferdinand Michel and Geneva Maria (Gonnering) Haberer. She married Raymond Joseph Cunningham on June 3, 1965 in River Forest, Illinois. He preceded her in death on March 8, 1981.

She graduated from Waterloo West High School in 1957 and earned her Registered Nurse degree in 1961, from Iowa Lutheran Hospital School of Nursing. She was a Registered Nurse with Concerned Care and then Advocate Home Health Services, retiring in 2004.
