CEDAR FALLS ? Mary H. Leland, 86, formerly of Western Home Communities Willowood, died Monday, May 29, at Bishop Drumm Care Center, Johnston.

She was born Sept. 2, 1919, in Des Moines, daughter of Glen D. and Elizabeth Deemer Head. She married Wilfred "Bill" C. Leland on Nov. 1, 1945, in Waterloo. He died March 23, 1998.
