Mary was born January 10, 1912, in Waterloo, Iowa, the daughter of William and Mary Naomi (Murray) Galloway. On January 28, 1934, she was united in marriage to Dean Paup in Chicago, IL. They were later divorced. She graduated from Waterloo West High School and State Teachers College (UNI) in Cedar Falls.
