Matthew L. "Matt" Hurley (1949-2011)

CEDAR FALLS- Matthew L. "Matt" Hurley, 61, of Cedar Falls died Tuesday, January 25, 2011 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, Iowa City.

He was born October 2, 1949 in Waterloo, the son of James and Agnes McCarville Hurley. He married Jane Clark in 1972 in Cedar Falls and they later divorced. He then married Patricia Ann Pinson on June 15, 1996 in St. Peters, Missouri.
