Maurine E. Jaquis (1932-2015)

NEW HARTFORD- Maurine E. Jaquis, 82, of New Hartford, died Friday, August 7, 2015, at the Western Home Communities.

She was born October 2, 1932 in Dumont, Iowa, daughter of Clifford E. and Hilda A. (Ahrens) White. She married Gordon M. Jaquis on November 28, 1952 in New Hartford. He died September 20, 1991.

Mrs. Jaquis attended Finchford Elementary, New Hartford Elementary and Secondary, and graduated from New Hartford High School. She earned her BA degree from the University of Northern Iowa and taught at New Hartford Community Schools for 47 years. She then was a substitute teacher at Lincoln Elementary in Cedar Falls, for 10 years, retiring in 2005.

Survived by: two daughters, Juline (Todd) Blanford and Elise (Robert) Howe, both of Cedar Falls; three grandchildren, Tom, Sam and Anna; two brothers, Maurice (Elaine) White of Waterloo and Paul (Lisa) White of Cedar Falls; and a sister, Linda (Donald) White of Tarkio, MO.
