WATERLOO – Michael R. Huffman, 69, of Waterloo, Iowa, died Friday, March 2, 2018 at Covenant Medical Center in Waterloo.

He was born August 14, 1948 in La Crosse, Wisconsin, son of Raymond and Rosemary (Lucey) Huffman. He married Donna Berry on January 7, 1967 in New Hampton, Iowa.
